What is an eBook?

An eBook is an electronic or digital version of a book that users can read on a personal computer, eReader or other portable devices such as tablets and smartphones. Our Library is proud to provide members with access to digital books from the Wheelers eBook Platform.

eBooks are protected by DRM (Digital Rights Management) which protects the copyright holders.

What is Digital Rights Management (DRM)

Libraries buy their eBook product from a vendor who has previously bought the right to supply these books to libraries from the publisher of the original book. The right to supply eBooks to libraries is not as simple as selling the eBook to the library and allowing the library to loan to their members. In a digital world the idea of loaning, in the way public libraries traditionally loan print books, is different as returning a digital file is unfeasible.

To resolve this vendors have had to come up with ways of delivering the eBook files to the reader in a way that suspends access to the file at the end of the library's loan period. This has been done by the use of software unique to the vendor which the reader agrees to use before they borrow their first book. These eBooks for loan cannot be read using any other software. This means you cannot renew an eBook, or return it.

This process also protects the copyright holder as files are unable to be downloaded and illegally distributed to others.

What eBook formats are available from Our Library?

PDF and EPUB are the standard eBook formats. Most computers, portable devices and eReaders are compatible with these formats.

PDF

Some titles available from Our Library have been produced by document scanning of the physical book. These titles retain the original layout and visual formatting of the book and therefore the text may not adjust to fit the screen of your device or computer. This format can be difficult to read on small screens.

EPUB

EPUB is short for electronic publication and is the growing standard for eBooks. The text and images in EPUB documents are reflowable and can therefore be optimised for the device you are using (text can be resized to adapt to your device).

Please check your device's user manual if you are not sure what formats your device supports.

Some devices may need an application to view or download the eBooks available from Our Library. For a list of suitable devices and compatible applications please visit <u>http://mornpen.wheelers.co/help/apps</u>.

Personal Computer?

It is recommended that you use Adobe Digital Editions to read eBooks from the eBook platform on your personal computer. To use Adobe Digital Editions you will need to create an Adobe ID.

Getting an Adobe ID

- 1. Go to the <u>www.adobe.com</u> and click **Sign In** (top right-hand corner).
- 2. Click on Create an Adobe Account



- 3. You only need to complete the required fields (those with a red asterix). Click on **continue** when you have completed the fields.
- 4. You have now created an Adobe ID. Your email address is your ID and the password you chose is obviously your password.

Getting Adobe Digital Editions

- 1. Go to <u>www.adobe.com</u> and search for **Adobe Digital Editions** in the search box select the icon when it appears.
- 2. Click Install (you may need to scroll down before you see the button).



- 3. You may receive the following message "*This application can read and write files to your system. Would you like to continue installing?*" Click on **install**.
- 4. Click on **Yes** when prompted to download and continue.
- 5. Depending on your operating system (Windows XP, Vista, Windows 7 etc.), you may be asked to verify that you wish to install the program. Select **Yes**.
- 6. The Adobe Digital Editions Setup will begin.

7. Click on **Next**, then **install**.

- 8. Once setup is completed click on **Close**.
- 9. Adobe Digital Editions may launch. Once again you may be prompted by the operating system to verify the program. Select **Yes**.
- 10. In order to activate Adobe Digital Editions, you will need an Adobe ID, if you have not done so already see **Getting an Adobe ID** on page 5.
- 11. The first time you run Adobe Digital Editions, you will be prompted to authorise it. Enter your Adobe ID and password. If you do not receive the prompt, click on the 'Library' on the top left of Adobe Digital Editions and scroll down to 'Authorize this computer', then enter your details.
- 12. When you download an eBook from the eBook Platform, Adobe Digital Editions will open automatically. You can access the eBook directly from Adobe Digital Editions at any time during your loan period.

If you need to access the eBook file itself (for example to transfer the eBook onto another reading device) it can be found in the **My Digital Editions** folder on your PC. The **My Digital Editions** folder can usually be found inside the **My Documents**, or **Documents** folder if you are a Windows 7 user.

eReader, Tablet or Smartphone?

iPhone, iPad and iPods

Apple devices require iOS 3.0 or higher and an App in order to download and view these eBooks. Our Library is using Bluefire Reader (also recommend by the eBook Platform). You will need an Adobe ID to use *Bluefire*, if you do not already have an Adobe ID, see **Getting an Adobe ID** on page 5.

To download BlueFire:

1. Tap on the App Store and search for **"Bluefire Reader"** and tap the result pictured.



- 2. Tap on the "Free" icon, it will convert to "Install", tap on this.
- 3. The application will start to install.
- 4. Once the App is installed you will need to authorize it in order to view eBooks. To do this you need your Adobe ID and password. Do not worry if you have not obtained an Adobe ID yet, you can do it from Bluefire.
 - a. I already have an Adobe ID
 - i. Tap the **Bluefire App**, select **Info** then **Authorize**.
 - ii. Tap the **Bluefire App** to open it.
 - b. I don't have an Adobe ID yet
 - i. Tap the **Get Adobe ID** button and follow the prompts.
- 5. When you borrow and download your eBook select 'Open in Bluefire Reader'.
- 6. Happy reading!

Android Devices

For Android devices the eBook Platform have suggested using the free **txtr** or **Aldiko** Apps. Both support DRM encrypted eBooks, however it is recommended you check with your provider or manufacturers website for suitable DRM encrypted ePub publications. Bluefire Reader can also be downloaded from the Google Play store and the downloading of eBooks will therefore be similar to the process for iPad, iPhone and iPods on page 16.

Amazon Kindle

Unfortunately most Kindle devices are not compatible with this eBook Platform as they are designed to work only with Amazon products. However, the new Amazon Kindle Fire will support Apps to read our eBooks. Our Library is aware there are questionable programs available that convert formats for the older Kindle products. Please note these practices breach DRM (Digital Rights Management) and Our Library therefore does not support the use of these programs.

On my computer (PC):

These instructions were developed using Internet Explorer, however you are free to use your preferred browser of choice. Please keep in mind if you are using a browser other than Internet Explorer, the steps may differ slightly from those outlined in these instructions.

Direct from the eBook Platform

- 1. Go to http://ourlibrary.mornpen.vic.gov.au/ and select the eBook icon. You will be directed to http://mornpen.wheelers.co/.
- 2. Click on Sign In in the top right-hand corner
- 3. Library Barcode: is your library card number PIN: is the PIN associated with your library card click on Sign In.
- 4. Browse or use the search box to search by title or author, you can refine your searches by filters (right hand side). If a title is shaded it means that it is currently on loan. The breadcrumb trail will help you keep track of your searching.



- 5. When you find a title you wish to borrow, click on the image.

There are two ways you can transfer your eBook onto your Apple device during your loan period. You can redownload it from the eBook Platform, or you can import it into iTunes from your **My Digital Editions** folder (this is the default folder Adobe Digital Editions creates on your PC to access the eBooks and can usually be found inside the **My Documents**, or **Documents** folder if you are a Windows 7 user).

Re-downloading an eBook from the eBook Platform

Any eBooks currently on loan to you will be listed in Your Account on the eBook Platform.

1. On your Apple device, go to mornpen.wheelers.co/ and select Your Account



2. On your profile screen click on Bookshelf.



3. Your "Shelf" will show items currently on loan to you and your "Loan History" is displayed below this. Click on the **download?** link beside the title you wish to transfer to your Apple device.



4. Tap on Open in "Bluefire"



5. The eBook will transfer to Bluefire Reader and is ready for reading.

Importing an eBook into iTunes (previously downloaded onto your PC via Adobe Digital Editions)

- 1. Open iTunes
- 2. Connect your device if you have not already done so
- 3. From the iTunes File dropdown menu, select Add File to Library



4. Go to the My Digital Editions folder (usually under My Documents or Documents folder) and select Open.



- 5. Select the title you wish to transfer and click on Open
- 6. The eBook will be transferred into the Books section of iTunes



7. You can now transfer the eBook onto your Apple device.
