

BIG Summer Read

Mornington Peninsula Libraries terms and conditions

How to enter:

1. Register at <https://plv.beanstack.org/>
2. Download the Beanstack app
3. Both parents and children sign up to Beanstack to register for the competition. The Beanstack app will record the books the children read and track progress. If your child is under the age of 13 you will need to permit them to register. As a parent, you can manage your families reading progress under one account.
4. Get Reading, between 1 December and 31 January 2022. Each child who registered is encouraged to read 10 books and complete a series of challenges.
5. Once they have finished 10 books they are entered into the major prize pools.
6. Each additional book finished gets a bonus entry.

Prize pool:

The following will be awarded in two age categories. Ages 0-8 and 9-17

1st prize - Family pass for 2 adults and 2 children to Enchanted Adventure Garden (valued at \$120)

2nd prize - \$50 book voucher from Farrells Bookshop Mornington

3rd prize - Children's book pack

Terms and conditions:

- You must be a member of the Mornington Peninsula Libraries to enter the draw
- Winners will be drawn at random and notified by Friday 11 February 2022
- The selection of winners is final and no correspondence regarding the competition will be entered into.
- Winners must be able to collect their prizes from a Mornington Peninsula Library branch in February 2022.
- The competition is open to all members of the Mornington Peninsula library except employees of the Mornington Peninsula Shire and their close relatives and anyone otherwise connected with the organisation or judging the competition.
