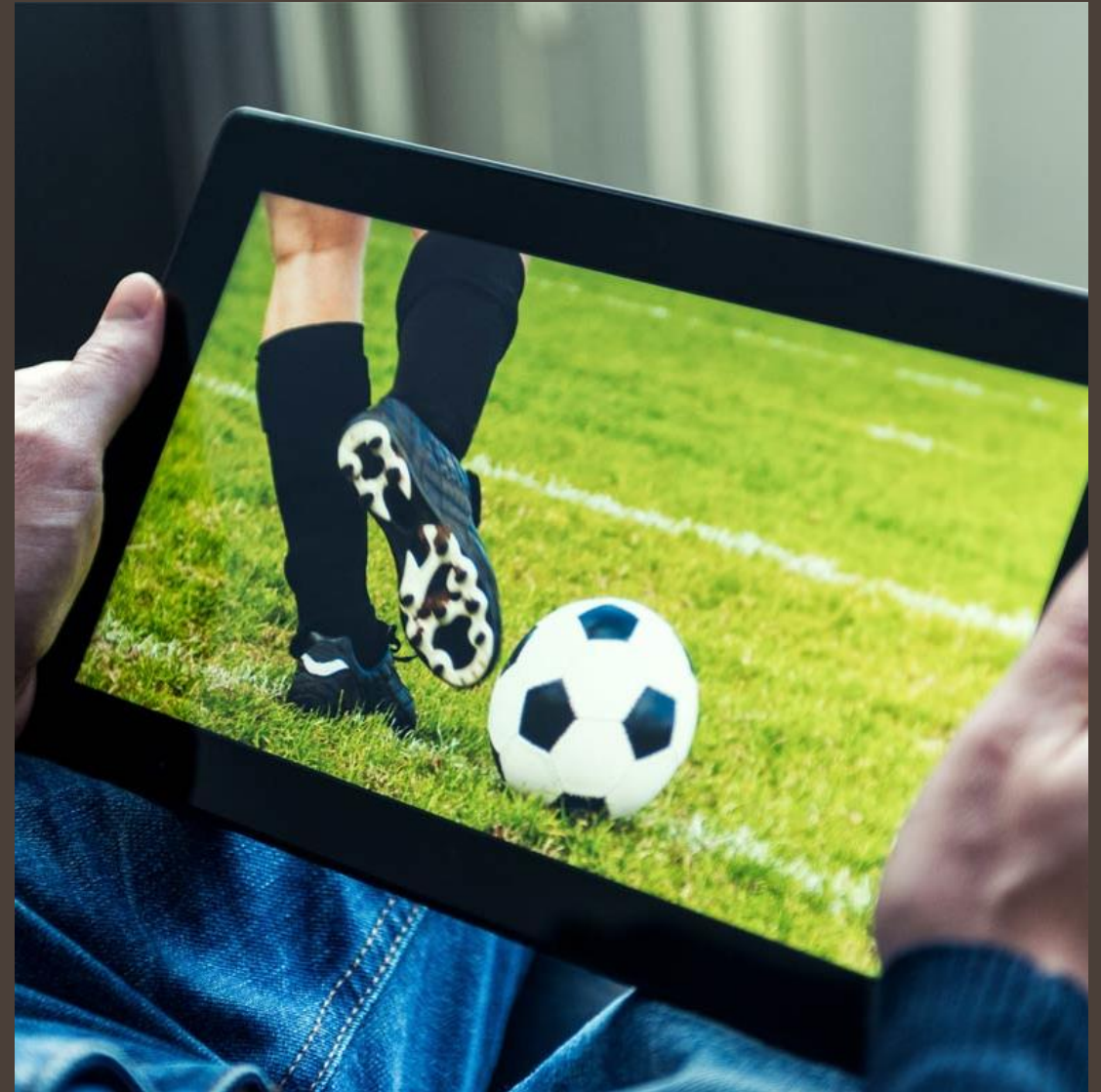

The internet has changed the way we watch TV, films, and even home videos, as well as how we listen to music. Catch-up TV services, online music applications, and video sharing sites mean that we can watch and listen to just about whatever we want, whenever we want.

You forgot that it was on, other s in your family didn't want to watch your program

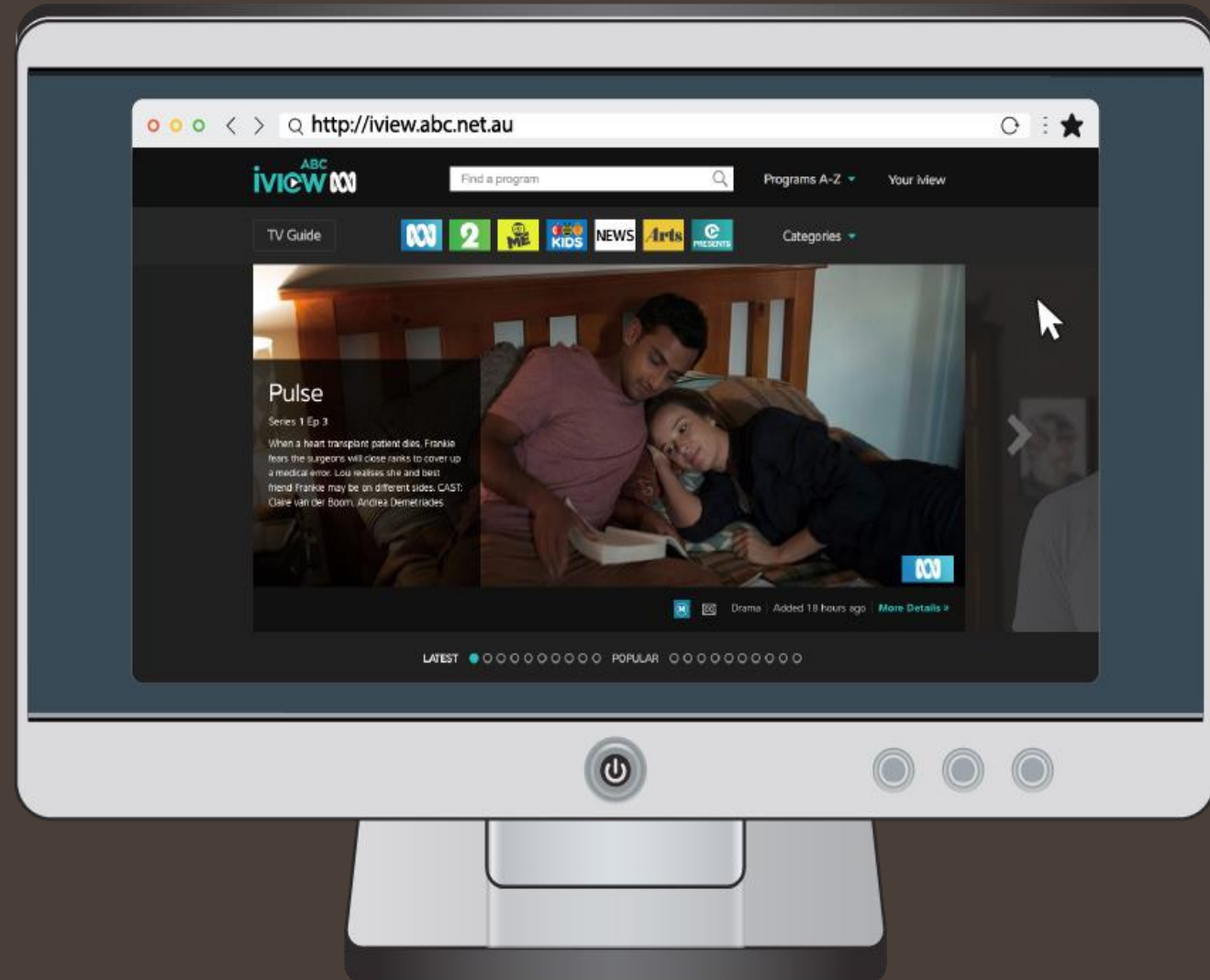


Catch-up services

There are online catch-up services for most TV channels, including ABC iview, SBS on Demand and Freeview.

You can use these services to watch programs which have been broadcast recently.

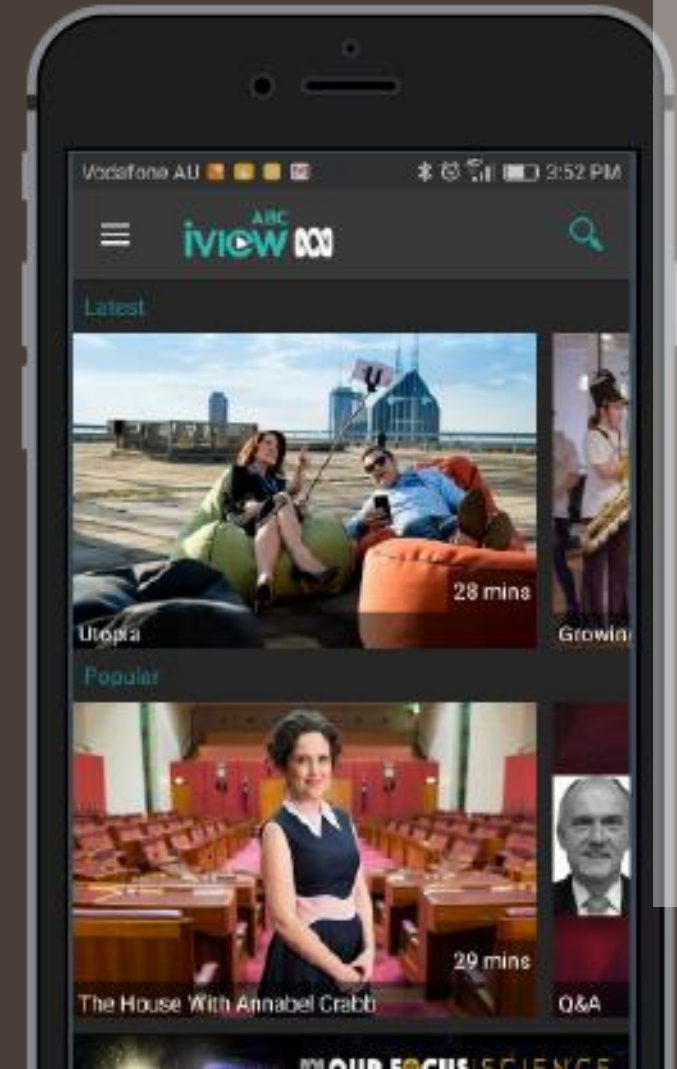
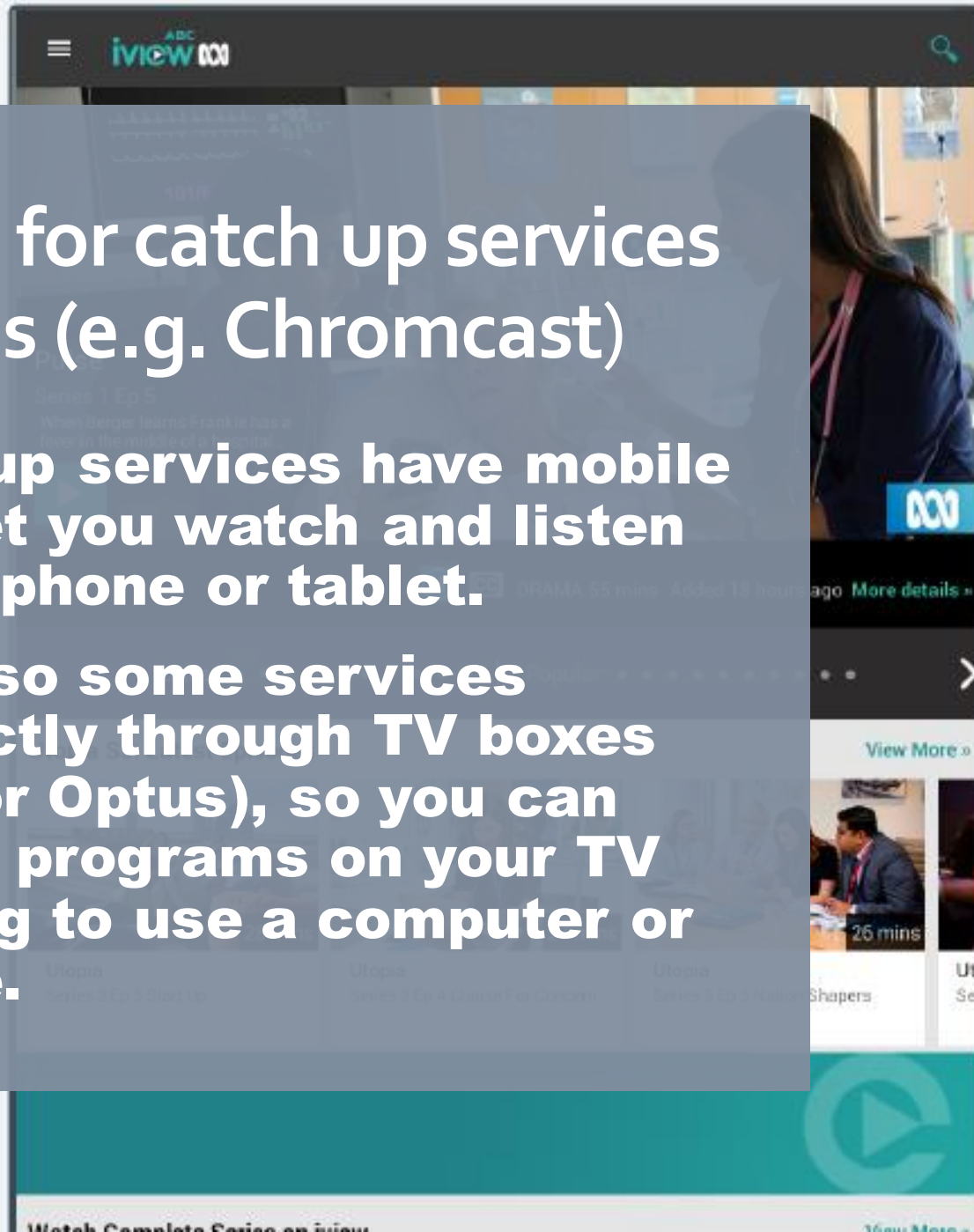
- Programs are only available on catch-up services for a set amount of time.
- However, some of them have banks of older programs which are still available to watch.



Mobile apps for catch up services and tv boxes (e.g. Chromcast)

Many catch-up services have mobile apps which let you watch and listen using a smartphone or tablet.

There are also some services provided directly through TV boxes (e.g. Telstra or Optus), so you can catch up with programs on your TV without having to use a computer or mobile device.

Netflix, Stan, and Foxtel let you watch a huge selection of films and television series online whenever you want. These services are paid for, known as subscription, but you can try it out using a free trial for new users.

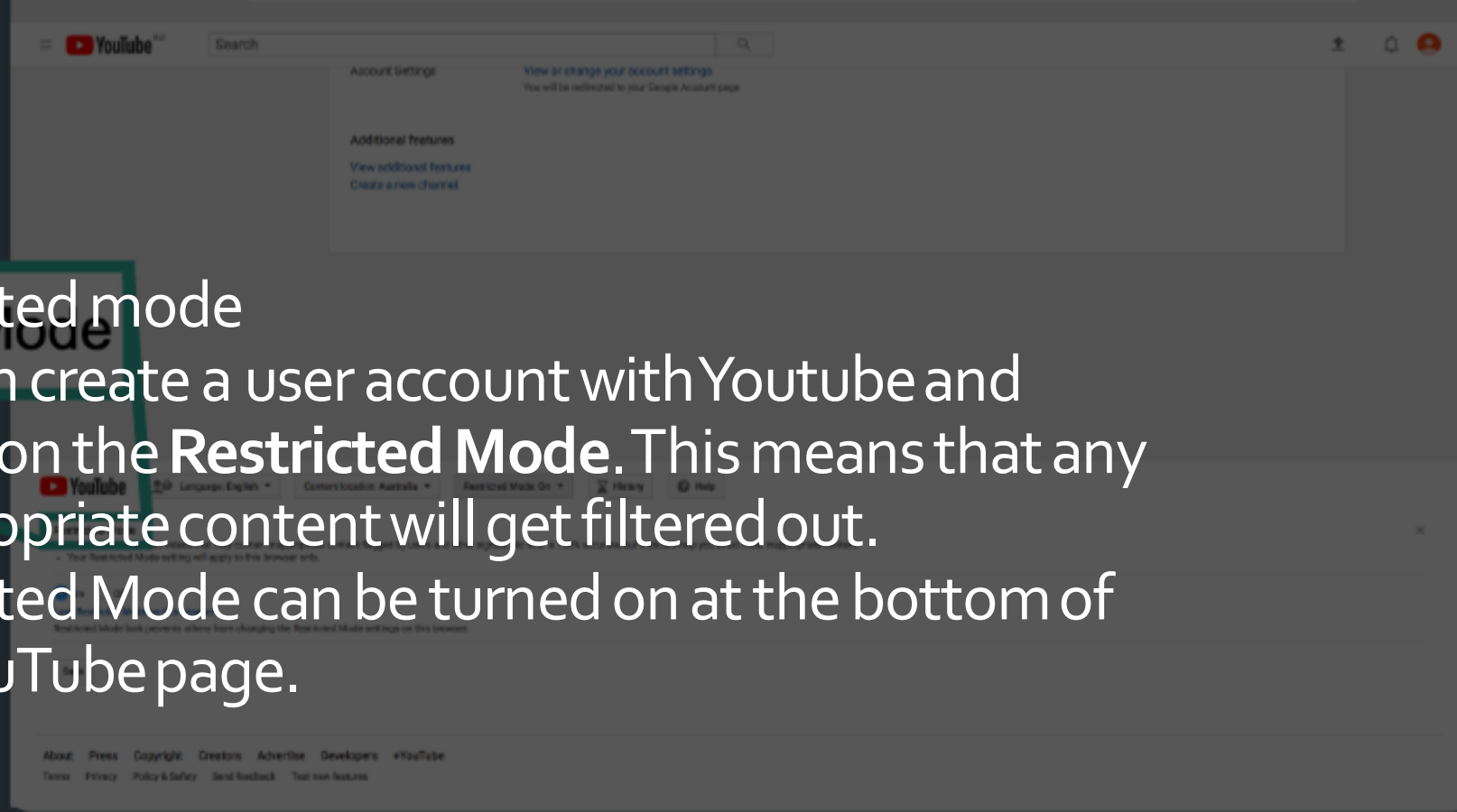
Something for everybody

Sarah and her Mum have noticed that the tap in the kitchen is dripping. Fortunately for Sarah, and her Mum, there's more to online videos than just cute animals.

Video sharing sites like YouTube, Dailymotion, and Vimeo are also good places to find help with all kinds of problems. You can use them to learn how to do new things. Lots of people upload step-by-step video guides that you can watch and follow.

*Step 1: Click once in the **Search** field at the top of the screen.*

Step 2: Type 'fix a leaky tap' into the search field.

Step 3: Click once on the magnifying glass icon.

Get tuned in -
online music

The internet offers a huge variety of music and talk radio you can listen to, for free and online, whether it be online radio or a music service such as Spotify. You can even listen to topical podcasts

which are like radio programs, but you can pause them and listen to them whenever you like.



You can use a monthly paid option for the streaming services. This will remove the adverts and give you extra features, like downloading music to listen to offline. Other safe sites to buy music include iTunes (only available for Apple customers) and Amazon.



How to access music online

- ❑ By **streaming** – listening to songs directly online, without downloading them.
- ❑ You have to be connected to the Internet



Spotify, Google Play Music and Apple Music offer a wide range of music to listen to online. You can save your favourite albums and create your own playlists.

Many of these streaming sites offer a free service. They usually have ads and no mobile access.



How much does it cost?

You will have to pay something to download music legally, even if it's just a small amount.

Downloading music legally can still be cheaper than buying CDs especially as you have the option of picking individual songs to download instead of whole albums.



Radio

Online radio stations not only survived but thrived.

There is a huge variety of radio stations that you can listen to online for free.

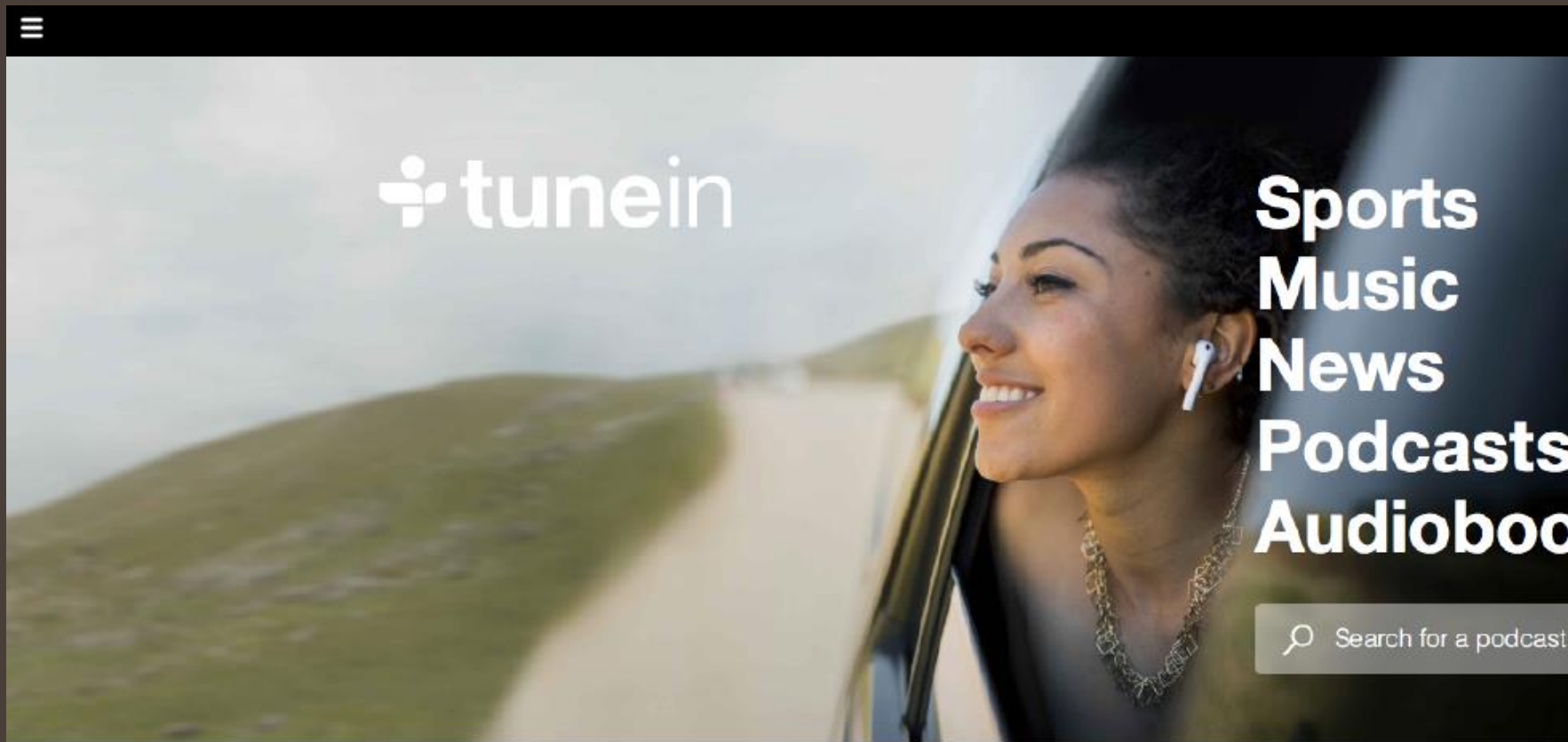

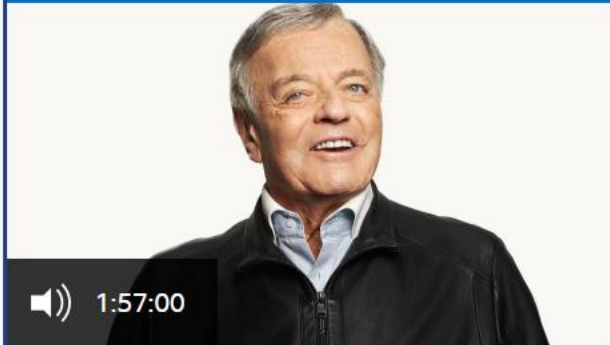

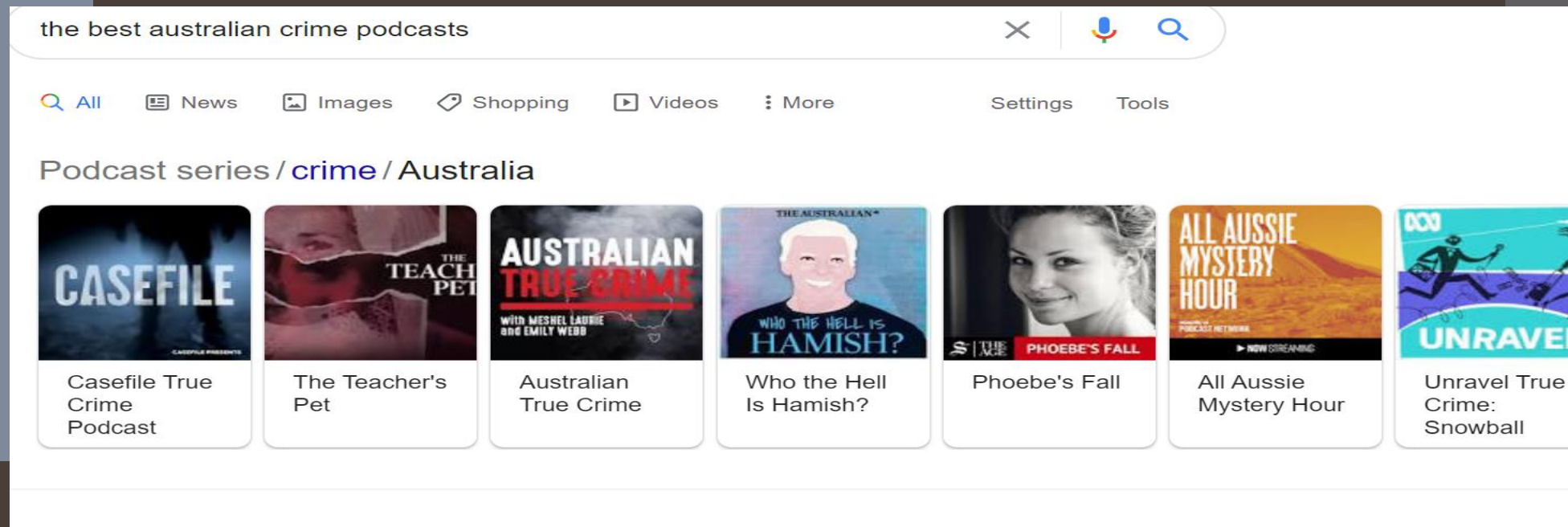


As you've seen during this course, there are different ways of watching and listening online to suit everyone. Whether you want to catch up with the best TV programs, make playlists of your favourite songs, or follow the news on the radio, there's a service out there for you.

How to listen to podcasts:

On the website

- You can listen to podcasts on a web browser like Chrome, Safari or Microsoft Edge - from a computer or from the web browser on your phone.
- Find a website that has podcasts you like, check out Guardian or search for the Australian best podcasts, any category of your interest like crime or books
- Find the player on the page, check your device's sound is switched on and click play to listen to the podcast.



How to listen to podcasts:

on your
iPhone

- Search your apps for 'Podcasts'. If it's not in your Settings with the list of apps or on the home screen, go to the App Store and download it.

Open the Podcast app and go to the search button at the bottom of the Podcasts page.

A search box should appear at the top : type in the name of the podcast you want to find eg: "Guardian Books" or a broad category like "US Election 2020" and Hit "enter" on your keyboard.

Choose the podcast you want from the search results and tap on it. This should take you to the podcast's homepage.

Once you're on the podcast homepage you'll see a list of recent episodes. Tap on one to play it.

If you like what you hear, a subscribe button at the top of the page lets you subscribe for free. This means the app will automatically download the latest episodes to your library.

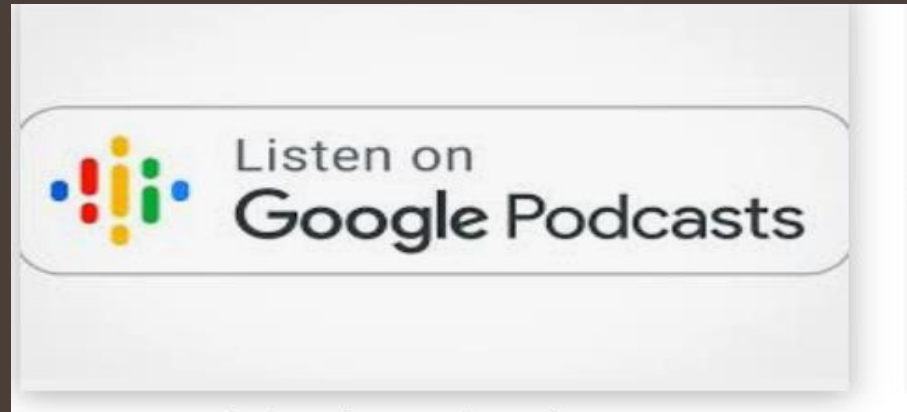

How to listen to podcasts:

On your Android phone

- **1. Search “Google podcasts” in the play store app**
- **2. Install the app**
- **3. Open the app and in a search box type the name of a particular podcast or a broad subject category, like Football**
- **4. Choose the podcast you want from the search results and tap on it again. This should take you to the podcast’s homepage.**
- **5. Once on the podcast homepage you should see a list of most recent episodes. Tap on one to play it.**
- **6. Tap the subscribe button at the top of the page.**
- **This will allow you to listen to new episodes**
